Thursday 12:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.
Friday 7:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

No Exceptions

Inside

Unreserved inside space will be assigned from the waiting list of the committee, on a first come first serve basis.

Dealers with reserved inside space must be in place and set up by 12:00 p.m. Friday or payment will be forfeited and space will be given to the next on list.

No Loading before 4:00 p.m. Sunday unless permission given by the committee.

No vehicles in the buildings at any time.

Unload and then move your vehicle away from the building to give another dealer the same opportunity as you.

Buildings will be locked at 8:00 on Thursday and 6:00 p.m. on Friday and Saturday

Buildings are to be empty no later than 6:00 p.m. Sunday.

NO SMOKING IN ANY BUILDING

Outside

Any dealer attempting to “Save His Space” prior to designated set-up times by roping or marking off any space will have said items removed and disposed of per the committee.

Lines on the road mark 15' frontage.

Camping permitted in Dealer's allotted space ONLY. Electricity and Water is only available in the Campground spaces.

Miscellaneous

Each dealer (inside and outside) must take their empty boxes and trash with them. We do not have the capability or manpower to provide trash removal service.

Outside food concessions will be hired by the committee.

No food or beverage sales (including bottled water and canned or bottled pop) permitted unless arrangement and approval is made in advance with committee.

The Ottawa County Agricultural Society has the authority to refuse/evict any dealer for language, obscenities and/or actions.

The Flea Market Committee reserves the right to stop the sale of any items, or refuse any setup, which is not felt to be in the best interest of the public or the Flea Market. The Flea Market Committee will settle any disputes.

Dealer agrees to be responsible to collect and report all appropriate sales tax to the proper Ohio taxing organization. The Ottawa County Agricultural Society shall not collect a percentage on sales, nor is responsible for dealers complying with Ohio sales tax laws.

Dealer bringing a pet (inside or outside) **MUST** come to the Senior Fair Board Office and register your pet. **All pets must be kept on a leash at all times.** This is to comply with the Health Department rules in reference to any animal bite.

These rules are strictly enforced!
