

Ottawa County Grande Parade Rules

Rules and Regulations:

1. Watch out for spectators running near or through parade route.
2. No reckless operation of any vehicle in parade.
3. Keep pace with the parade speed.
4. Do not pass other entries in the parade with the exception of the entry being stopped for an emergency.
5. Entries are not allowed to stop during the parade except for emergencies.
6. In case of emergency, units are directed to pull to the side of parade route. Please respect request, respond in an urgent and cooperative manner.
7. No sirens permitted.
8. No one is permitted to ride on the hood of a vehicle.
9. No fire twirling or any kind of fire use.
10. If throwing candy, please be aware of the surrounding, underhand tosses only to prevent injury. Please make sure if you are throwing candy it clears the parade route so no persons get caught in the parade and is injured.
11. Alcoholic beverages are strictly forbidden during the parade and in staging area.
12. Water balloons and water guns are strictly prohibited.
13. All animals participating in the parade must be leashed.
14. Horse entries must supply their own clean up.
15. Display parade number for the duration of the parade.

With entry in the Ottawa County Fair Grande Parade I understand and agree to the rules and regulations stated above by the Ottawa County Jr. Fair parade committee.

I agree and understand that the Ottawa County Agriculture Society cannot be held responsible for any damages, fees incurred for injury, illness or loss of personal property. The parade committee working with the Ottawa County Sr. Fairboard has the right to remove applicants for violation of parade or fair rules.
