



2023 Pig Scramble Rules and Entry Form

- Contestants must be between 5 - 13 years of age.
- Deadline to Register is July 16 at 5 p.m.
- Scramble is capped at 100 kids.
- Registrations will be taken at the Fair Board office up until July 16 at 5 p.m. or 100 kids register, whichever comes first!
- Registration fee is \$5 and must be paid at time of entry. Fee is non-refundable.
- At least one parent or guardian must be present during the scramble.
- Closed toed shoes are required.
- Officials will be inside the arena at all times to help the contestants. Contestants will be instructed on proper catching technique at time of event.
- All contestants must be present for check-in and to be divided into age divisions 15 minutes prior to the start of the event. Late arrivals may not be permitted to compete.
- Cash prizes will be awarded to those who catch a pig and will have first chance at purchasing a pig.
- To be deemed as having "caught a pig," the contestant must place the rope given to them around the leg of the pig and remain holding on until one of the officials arrives. If a participant has hold of a pig, no other participant will be allowed to touch the pig until it breaks away. If two of more participants catch the same pig, the pig will be turned loose.
- Unnecessary roughness will not be tolerated; participants will be disqualified and the pig will be set free.
- All judges' decisions are final.
