2024 CAMPING GUIDELINES

!!!!PLEASE NOTE NEW OR CHANGED GUIDELINES!!!!

Names that are registered for the 2024 fair will be checked against names on the sign in list when you park your camper.

- 1. Due to health code regulations, all waste water Black/Gray water CANNOT BE DUMPED/DRAINED ON GROUND. You must dispose of it appropriately. Violation of this rule will result in losing your camping spot for 2025. THIS WILL BE ENFORCED! NO EXCEPTIONS!**
2. There is **NO PARKING** of any vehicle in rows B to E or F on the odd numbered sites. We do allow one vehicle to park in row F on the even number sites as long as they are safely off the road and not on your neighbor's site. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** You first will be asked to move. 2nd violation will result in losing camping spot for 2025 and vehicle will be towed at owner's expense.
3. The camping adult who is responsible for campsite must be 19 years of age (as of January 1, 2024.)
4. All camping units must have an **ADULT IN ATTENDANCE ON FAIRGROUNDS**
5. Each person 9yrs and older, in a camping unit, must have a fair pass to the 2024 Ottawa County Fair. Adult fair passes must be purchased prior to or at the time of camping registration.
6. Only one vehicle per campsite can park in the campground parking lot and must have the parking tag visible. All other vehicles must park in the

main parking lot. You will be towed at the owner's expense if vehicle is found to be in violation.

7. Camping unit shall consist of: One tent, one trailer, or one truck camper, Etc. If an additional small tent is needed a \$5.00 fee will be added regardless of how long the tent is occupying the space. Any additional tent must remain within your campsite.
8. To respect those who have early shows, the following quiet hours will be strictly enforced.
Monday - Thursday 11pm to 6am Friday and Saturday 1am to 6am.
Please remember sounds carry at night, excessive noise or other nuisances are not permitted after hours. Keep radios and talking down to with-in your campsite.
9. All Electric connections need to be grounded. **NO REFRIGERATORS OR FREEZERS ARE ALLOWED OUTSIDE OF CAMPER.**
10. Camping site number and name must be displayed on all units so it is **visible from the road.**
11. Camping units shall be parked and checked in as directed by Camping Director beginning at 8:00 am to 8:00 pm on Saturday July 13, 2024. If you paid for early pull-in Friday July 12, 2024, check in will be from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm.
12. All propane tanks for camping must be fastened down.
13. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE PERMITTED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS. ONLY IN DESIGNATED AREAS. ANY UNDERAGE DRINKERS WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE FAIRGROUNDS AND OR A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER WILL BE CALLED.**
14. All pets must be registered prior to opening day of the fair. Pets are to be confined to your campsite and **MUST** remain leashed and under

control. Please be considerate of other campers and keep your pet on **YOUR CAMPSITE**. **Pets are NOT permitted on the midway, in any barn or near food stands**. Owners will be required to remove un-registered pets from the Fairgrounds. You **MUST** clean up after your pet, please be considerate of other people/campers.

15. **No fair project animals (horses, cows, sheep, goats, etc.) will be permitted in the campgrounds unless in Monday's Grand Parade. You must pick up after your animals during and after parade. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
16. **CAMPFIRES WILL NOT BE PERMITTED**
17. We will not tolerate any reckless driving or speeding. Any violation of rules or unsafe operation will result in either a written warning or immediate removal from the fairgrounds. **SPEED LIMIT FOR ALL VEHICLES IS 5 MPH IN CAMPGROUNDS. THIS IS FOR YOUR SAFETY AND EVERYONE IN CAMPGROUND. PLEASE NO SPEEDING!!**
18. **All campers will be responsibility to take their trash to a blue Republic tote or the dumpster back by the river.**
19. **Campers will come in the West Gate 1 for camper pull-in, (see map).** The rest of the week, camping with window passes should come in East Gate 3. If you are just dropping off supplies to a camper, you will be required to leave your driver license with the gate worker. It will be returned upon exiting the campground. There will be a 30-min limit on drop off.
20. Because of the manner everyone hooks up the water line, it will be each camper's responsibility to have a "Backflow Prevention" on the lead of your hose.
21. **FIREWORKS ARE NOT PERMITTED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS.**

22. **Check out time for campers to leave the fairgrounds is at 5:00 PM on Sunday the last day of the fair.** Anyone that leaves prior to 5 pm without prior approval with the camping director will forfeit their spot for the following year. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR CAMPSITE IS CLEAN.
23. All campers must be removed by Wednesday July 24, 2024 by 8:00 PM. Any camper left after that date will be assessed a \$30 fee per day. A/C must be turned off by Monday morning, July 24th.
24. ANY CAMPSITE INDIVIDUAL FOUND TO BE IN VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE ABOVE RULES, WILL BE ISSUED A WRITTEN WARNING.
25. UPON A SECOND VIOLATION, THE VIOLATOR COULD BE REQUIRED TO REMOVE THE CAMPING UNIT FROM THE FAIRGROUNDS. AND/OR FORFEIT THEIR SITE RESERVATION PRIVILEGES FOR THE FOLLOWING YEAR.
26. DEPENDING ON THE SEVERATY OF VIOLATION, IT WILL BE UP TO THE CAMPING COMMITTEE'S DECISION.
27. NO BIKES ON THE FAIRGROUNDS!
28. BE SURE YOUR ELECTRICAL SYSTEM IS OPPERATING CORRECTLY. DO NOT EXCEED 24 AMPS ON A 30 AMP SERVICE. DO NOT EXCEED 40 AMPS ON A 50 AMP SERVICE! YOU WILL INCURE A SERVICE CHARGE OF A \$50N MINIMUM IF OUR CONTRACTED ELECTRICAL COMPANY HAS TO REPAIR OR RESTORE ANY SERVICE DUE TO OVER AMPAGE ON YOUR PART.
